# **Online Safeguarding Children Recertification - User Guide**

# What is the Online Safeguarding Children Recertification course?

The Online Safeguarding Children Recertification course is a convenient way to make sure that your knowledge is up to date, and that you have a valid Safeguarding Children certificate. Updating should happen every three years. Anyone who has done The FA three hour face to face Safeguarding Children Workshop can do the Online recertification.

The course gives practical examples of football situations and explores how to deal with them .There is a recap of the face to face Safeguarding course, but the course also includes new information, like changes in the law and information on how to protect children on the internet.

#### **Enrolling on the course**

#### 1. Paying for the course or Entering your discount/free code.

# Online Safeguarding Children Recertification – User FAQs

# Can I do the Online course?

Anyone who has done The FA three hour face to face Safeguarding Children Workshop can do the Online recertification.

This means that even if you have previously taken the paper recertification you can still update your qualification using the Online Safeguarding Children Recertification course.

If, however, you took the distance learning pack 'The Guide' you will need to take the three hour workshop. This is because The Guide does not explore issues in the same way as the workshop and its important all adults working with children attend the workshop at least once.

#### I can't access the payment screen

This may be because you do not have a Safeguarding workshop attached to your FAN number. Please email <u>onlinesafeguardingquery@thefa.com</u> and we will check your records.

#### I can't access Members' Services

If you have made payment or entered a free code for the course, this should grant you access to Members' Services. It may take 24 hours for this to be processed. If after 24 hours you are still unable to access the course please email <u>onlinesafeguardingquery@thefa.com</u>

# I have paid. How do I start the course?

The course is held on the Members' Services section of your local County FA website. You will have to log in with the same FAN and password as you used to pay/enter your free code with.

#### I would like to make payment for someone else to do the course. Can I do this?

Yes of course. Log in with the FAN and password of the person that is doing the course. You can then pay with your card or enter a free code on their behalf.

#### In Member Services my course says 'Enrol' but when I click that link, it won't open. What do I do?

Your 'pop up blocker' is probably preventing you from accessing the course. Please 'enable' or 'allow' pops ups.

The help tab in your web browser (Internet Explorer, Mozilla Firefox or Google Chrome) will explain how to do this if it does not seem straightforward.

#### Do I have to do the course all at once or can I login and logout?

You can log in and out as and when it suits you.
